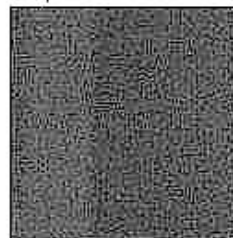

MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

SUBJECT: Approval System for BOW TIE Missions (Taiwan Strait)

1. [REDACTED] of the JRC called this morning to request that the Director be alerted to the fact that at the Special Group on Thursday, 13 December, the JRC would be requesting approval for CINCPAC to execute a specified number of BOW TIE missions over the Taiwan Strait area without referral in each case to the JCS or Special Group.

2. In answer to my question, [REDACTED] stated that these missions would be flown against CINCPAC theater requirements. I told him that I would advise COMOR on 13 December of the intended JRC action, looking toward a COMOR determination of the Community's requirements for this area inasmuch as the Taiwan Strait situation is of XI as well as CINCPAC concern. I also believe for the most part our requirements will be mutually compatible.

3. For your information, in the last 3 months there were 2 BOW TIE missions in August, 1 in October, none in November and 1 in December.
